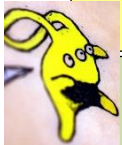
Year 1 Newsletter Autumn Term 2

Our topic this half term is:
Where we live.



English

Children will be continuing to develop their phonic knowledge, reading and writing skills. We will look at poems about bonfire night and create our own. We will be reading Zog, an innovate the characters in our stories. We will be starting to explore comprehension texts.



Topic
