Thank you to all those who made it to our ZOOM chat this morning. Remember it is really important that you do because that is when I will take the register.


This is our timetable for today's home learning:

Why does Stanley feel sorry for the driver?



What colour might the socks have been at first?



Spelling, Handwriting and Grammar


L.O. to correctly form bottom joins


You can copy these handwriting sheets even if you cannot get on the program.
